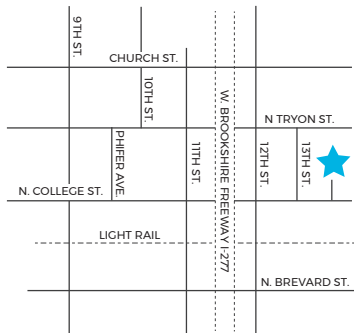

CONCERNED ABOUT THE WELL-BEING OF SOMEONE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS?

We are grateful for the Charlotte community making us aware of people in need. Here are immediate steps you can take:

-  Invite the individual to visit Roof Above's Day Services Center. You can tear off the card below to share with the individual.
-  Make a request for our street outreach team to check in on the individual and situation at <https://bit.ly/3vxYqZk>.
-  Inquire if the individual has called 704-284-9665. If they have not, encourage them to do so. Available 24/7, coordinated entry is a process that aims to connect individuals and families who are homeless, or those at imminent risk of homelessness, to an existing available shelter/housing resource in the Charlotte-Mecklenburg community. If you call 704-284-9665 (or 888-892-1162), a representative can share more on this process.

- Daily lunch (11:15am - 12:15pm)
- Showers, laundry, restrooms, device charging
- Nurse, prescription assistance, over-the-counter medications
- Help with obtaining ID, bus passes (for verified work/medical appointment), and more
- Phone, fax, and mail
- Connections to community resources
- First step to emergency shelter and housing
